

- The Dieselboss Co-Pilot Truck 11 install and setup guide -



Please refer to the following guide when you get your CoPilot truck routing GPS to get it installed and routing you correctly.

PLEASE NOTE: the product will be configured for DEFAULT settings when you install it and this guide assumes that you are driving a 48' or 53' semi truck and trailer. DEFAULT settings WILL NOT be routing you on the trucking roads, so you must understand and configure the truck routing features of this GPS in order to take advantage of the big-truck routing.

Step 1: Installation

- **DO NOT plug the receiver into your computer yet.**
- Put the DVD in the DVD drive and follow the on-screen prompts to install the program and the User Guide to your computer. This will take about 10 minutes. You will need the code from the small red and white book during this step.
- When the install finishes, start the Co-Pilot truck one time and follow the on-screen prompts to activate the program. If you do not have an internet connection at this time, you can cancel the activation and the program will still function normally for 3 days before it will REQUIRE that you do activate it to work.
- Close Co-Pilot Truck after starting it this first time.
- **Plug in the USB receiver** and wait about 30 seconds for Windows to set up the receiver drivers.
- **Start Co-Pilot Truck** again now using the icon on the desktop and it will use the receiver to automatically find your current position.

Step 2: Truck routing

- With Co-Pilot now open and the receiver functioning, close any "tips and tricks" or "destination" windows that may be currently open.
- **Click on the red "Menu" button** at the bottom-left of the screen and click "Settings" and then "Routing."
- **Choose "Routing Type - Practical"** | Choose your own preference on whether to take toll roads | Click the checkbox for "53 ft trailer" (this will automatically turn on the National Network as well | **DO NOT** click on "Override restrictions" unless you are bob-tailing | Only click the box for "International borders open" if you want to allow CoPilot to route you through parts of Canada or if you regularly take loads across the border
- **Click** on any of the HazMat options if you are hauling that kind of HazMat.
- **Scroll** to the bottom of this window and click on "Save as Routing Profile" and then give this profile a name, such as "LongHaul" or "53-ft No Hazmat" or "Bob's Profile." It does not matter what you name it, and you can make as many routing "Profiles" as you want for different types of routing. Click "OK" to save the profile and close this window.
- Now, **click on "View / Edit Road Preferences."** This will bring up a window that will allow you to tell Co-Pilot which kinds of roads that you prefer. Most commonly drivers will choose "Strongly Favor" on Freeways and Divided Highways, "Neutral" on Primary Highways, "AVOID" on Secondary Roads, and "STRONGLY AVOID" on Local streets. Click "Ok" when you have made your choices to close this window.
- **Click "OK"** again to exit your "Routing Preferences" window.

Step 3: Other Features

- If you followed the steps above correctly, your trucking GPS is now configured for **truck driving routes only**, which will keep you as safe as possible. You can modify those settings as you use Co-Pilot to fit your needs and your driving style, but many drivers asked that we create this basic "first-time" setup guide for them to get started.
- **There are MANY** more features available in this program for you to use and they are described in the "Users Guide" that was installed on your desktop.
- **Please take time to read** the users guide for more feature information.
- The most common other features that drivers need to configure are: POI alerts so that Co-Pilot warns you when you are approaching weigh stations, truck stops, rest areas, etc | real-time traffic information (as long as you have an internet connection in your rig | and your "Voice" and "Driving Views" preferences.
